PAYMENT INFORMATION

COST BREAKDOWN

- **\$50/DAY** – housing, meals, one fun night, etc
- **\$50** – one-time cost for equipment and supplies for Projects of Renewal
- **\$50** – one-time donation to MACC Development
 - *Videos, panels, discussions, documentaries, and activities*

Weeklong Total Cost: 5-6 days: **\$350-\$400 PER PERSON**

PAYMENT NORMS

- The cost above includes all trip expenses except for those associated with transportation.
- Please make whole-group payments and send them to MACC Development and send them to 7900 Mack Ave, Detroit, MI 48214.
- Your deposit of \$500 serves as your reservation of the dates for your trip if you choose to make it nonrefundable. This deposit should be made 4 months prior to arrival but can be made earlier in order to reserve your trip dates.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you decide to cancel your trip, please contact Ginny immediately. If you cancel your trip:

- Your deposit will not be refunded.
- If you choose to make your initial deposit refundable, you will receive it back if you cancel 10 weeks prior to your trip. Once your trip is 10 weeks away, your deposit becomes nonrefundable and you will be contacted to inform you that your trip is finalized.
- 30 days prior to your arrival, any payments made above the \$500 deposit will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of your arrival, none of payments received will be refunded.

Please understand that once you confirm your trip dates with your nonrefundable deposit, we begin preparing for your experience here. When you cancel a trip, it impacts our ministry in a variety of ways. Not only have we spent time preparing for your trip, we also plan for the expected impact we can have based on your trip. This includes work projects and employment opportunities for our community members. When you commit to coming on the trip through your deposit, please do your best to insure that you will be able to follow through on that commitment. We understand that things happen that are outside of your control, but we ask that you take into consideration the impact a cancelled trip has on our ministry before you commit to attend.
